Safe Teen Schedule Updates	Marjorie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coalition members can record their DST segments at the hospital or on their own through Zoom <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids won't be watching live • Record and send to Marjorie and she will save file to Google for students and teachers to access • What Zoom account will coalition use? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can coalition use WCDPHE's or RETAC's Zoom account? • A one-year one-host business Zoom account would cost \$149.90 (unlimited meetings, up to 100 participants per meeting) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coalition will find out if CDOT funds can be used to pay for a coalition Zoom account • Valley, Roosevelt, Highland are all interested in providing DST programming whether it be virtual or in-person (if able)
