<b>Safe Teen Program</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Virtual Program Filming Updates</b></li> </ul>	<b>Stacey, Marjorie and Casey</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stacey and Jordin have filmed</li> <li>• Marjorie has posted other short educational videos on the site for schools to refer to</li> <li>• Sue, law enforcement ( Marjorie trying to get Officer Matt, Valley, to record) and Scott (big rigs) still need to film their presentations</li> <li>• Roosevelt has presented DST material – Officer Kelly presented law enforcement segment to four different classes for a total of 115 kids</li> <li>• Valley hasn't yet presented — want to wait until all segments are uploaded</li> <li>• Stacey available all day Monday-Friday starting in January for live Zoom presentations if schools are interested</li> <li>• GWHS did one cohort seat belt check</li> <li>• Marjorie continues to reach out to schools on eastern plains – Holyoke, Brush, Fort Morgan</li> </ul>

<p><b>BUDS Program Updates</b></p>	<p><b>Marjorie</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two newest schools haven't done anything yet <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Marjorie continues to send activity ideas</li> </ul> </li> <li>• 4,123 students reached at 3 high schools with different BUDS activities targeting GDL, seat belts, distracted driving, etc. during Oct.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Virtual Parent of Teen Drivers Class</b></p> <p><b>Partnership with Anshor and Elite to promote our on-line class</b></p>	<p><b>Casey</b></p> <p><b>Kelly</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Casey still needs to get a hold of the slides from Parent of Teen Drivers class <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Randy has slides on a jump drive Casey/Kelly will reach out</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Coalition will consider a virtual recording with Randy if already recorded audio over the slides doesn't work out</li> <li>• Coalition will at least put some slides up as soon as possible so they are there for use – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Let Anshor/Elite know when slides are up so they can refer their clients</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Coalition says maybe it's not worth it and it probably wouldn't be able to be reimbursed</li> </ul>

<p><b>Open Floor</b></p>	<p><b>Everyone</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tamara submitted grant request for \$10K from State Farm <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No 2.97% fee anymore</li> <li>• Grants awarded January /beginning of February</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Kelly reprinted 1,000 carseat postcards <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Paid for with CDOT funds</li> </ul> </li> <li>• LifeSavers conference is virtual this year in April <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$300, CDOT may be able to help pay registration fees</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Marjorie sent carseat and GDL cards to Fort Lupton and they distributed them at trunk or treat event</li> </ul>
